- A. Other disciples witness to Thomas, he does not believe and seeks hard proofs (v.24-25)
 - i. Jesus stood among disciples and asked Thomas, "Put your finger...stop doubting and believe,"
 - i. Do not become unbelieving (apistos) but believing (pistos)
- B. Thomas utters the greatest confession: "My Lord and my God" (v. 27-28)
- C. Jesus stood among disciples and asked Thomas, "Put your finger...stop doubting and believe,"

- D. Some practical implications
 - i. Thomas' story could be a gift for people today
 - ii. Mother Teresa's temptation to give up, and we have a job to do: we need to continue believing and help people to believe

V. Why Did John Write His Gospel?

- A. Jesus did many other signs in the presence of disciples; they are not recorded in his book (v. 30)
- B. The Good News: "...Believe that Jesus is Messiah, the Son of God and that by believing you may have life in his name"

- B. Jesus said, "Blessed are those who don't see, yet they believe!" (John 20:29a)
